

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWN OF SAN LUIS, ARIZONA, AMENDING THE SAN LUIS CODE BY ADDING ARTICLE 4-4 WHICH CREATES THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC SAFETY; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF SAN LUIS, ARIZONA AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1.

The San Luis code is hereby amended by adding Article 4-4 which shall state as follows:

Article 4-4 DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC SAFETY

- 4-4-1 Created
- 4-4-2 Director
- 4-4-3 Appointment of Officers
- 4-4-4 Functions

Section 4-4-1 Created

There is hereby created a Department of Public Safety which shall consist of a director and as many officers as may be deemed necessary by the Council for the safety and good order of the Town.

Sec. 4-4-2 Director

The department shall be headed by a director who shall serve as both the Chief of Police and Fire Chief, and who shall be appointed by the Council and shall serve at the pleasure of the Council.

Sec. 4-4-3 Appointment of Officers

The director shall appoint or hire as many officers as approved by the Council, said officers to act as both Policemen and Firemen after necessary training and qualification.


Sec. 4-4-4 Functions

All other functions of the department shall be as set forth in Chapter 4 of the San Luis code and as determined by the Council.

Section 2 - Declaration of an Emergency


Whereas, it is necessary for the preservation of the peace, health and safety of the Town of San Luis, Arizona, an emergency is declared to exist, and this ordinance shall become immediately operative and in force on and after the date of adoption by the Town Council of the Town of San Luis, Arizona.

PASSED AND ADOPTED by the Common Council of the Town of San Luis, Arizona this 11th day of August, 1982.


