ORDINANCE NO. 289

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF SAN LUIS, ARIZONA, RELATING TO CHAPTER 7 BUSINESS OF THE CITY CODE OF THE CITY OF SAN LUIS, AMENDING SAID CHAPTER TO ADD ARTICLE 7-4 "SEXUALLY ORIENTED BUSINESSES"; REPEALING ANY CONFLICTING PROVISIONS; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY AND PROVIDING PENALTIES FOR VIOLATIONS; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN LUIS, ARIZONA:

Section 1: Chapter 7 Business of the City Code of the City of San Luis is hereby amended by adding Article 7-4 "Sexually Oriented Businesses" in accordance with that certain document entitled "Article 7-4 Sexually Oriented Businesses", three copies of which are on file in the Office of the Clerk of the City of San Luis, Arizona, which document was made a public record by Resolution No. of the City of San Luis, Arizona. Said document, "Article 7-4 Sexually Oriented Businesses" is hereby referred to, adopted, and made a part hereof as if fully set forth again in full.

Section 2: Any person found guilty of violating any provision of Article 7-4 "Sexually Oriented Businesses" shall be guilty of a class one misdemeanor and punished pursuant to the provisions of Section 7-4-99 as set forth in said Article 7-4 "Sexually Oriented Businesses". Each day that a violation continues shall be a separate offense punishable as herein above described.

Section 3: If any section, subsection, sentence, clause, phrase or portion of this ordinance or any part of these amendments to the City Code adopted herein by reference is for any reason held to be invalid or unconstitutional by the decision of any court of competent jurisdiction, such decision shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions thereof.

Section 4: Whereas, it is necessary for the preservation of the peace, health, safety and welfare of the City of San Luis, Arizona, and for further reason that the best interest of the City require the amendments to Chapter 7 and Article 7-4 "Sexually Oriented Businesses" to go into immediate effect, an emergency is declared to exist, and this ordinance and the amendments adopted pursuant to its provisions shall become immediately operative and in force from and after the date of posting hereof.
