AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF SAN LUIS AMENDING THE OCCUPATIONAL LICENSE AND MISCELLANEOUS BUSINESS REGULATIONS OF THE CITY TO PROVIDE FOR PERMISSIBLE CONSUMER FIREWORKS AND MEDICAL MARIJUANA DISPENSARIES AND CULTIVATION LOCATIONS; REPEALING ANY CONFLICTING PROVISIONS; AND PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and Council of the City of San Luis, Arizona as follows:

Section 1: Chapter 7-3 Occupational Licenses and Miscellaneous Business Regulations, is hereby amended by revising Section 7-3-11 Definitions by renumbering B to C, C to D, D to E, E to F, F to G, G to H, H to I, I to J, J to K, K to L, L to M, and M to O and to add new subparagraphs B and N as follows:

B. Medical Marijuana Dispensary shall mean a nonprofit medical marijuana dispensary duly registered and certified pursuant to A.R.S. § 36 2804, and Medical Marijuana Dispensary Offsite Cultivation Location shall mean the one additional location, if any, duly identified pursuant to A.R.S. § 36 2806 (E) during the process of registering a nonprofit medical marijuana dispensary, where marijuana will be cultivated for sale at a nonprofit medical marijuana dispensary duly registered and certified pursuant to A.R.S. § 36 2804.

N. Permissible Consumer Fireworks Business means a business that sells any permissible consumer fireworks as defined by A.R.S. §36-1601, whether as a principal or ancillary use, including, but not limited to, as its own business or in conjunction with any other business or professional activity.

Section 2: In the event of a conflict between the provisions of this Ordinance and any other ordinance, resolution, regulation, or policy of the City of San Luis, the conflicting provisions are hereby repealed, superseded, and replaced, and the provisions of this ordinance shall govern.

Section 3: If any section, subsection, sentence, clause, phrase, or portion of this Ordinance is for any reason held to be invalid or unconstitutional by the final decision of any court of competent jurisdiction, such decision shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions of this Ordinance.


