AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF SAN LUIS, ARIZONA, RELATING TO THE PRIVILEGE TAX; AMENDING THE CITY TAX CODE BY ELIMINATING THE EXCLUSION OF TRANSACTIONS WITH SPECIFIED GOVERNMENTAL AGENCIES; ESTABLISHING EFFECTIVE DATE; MAKING PROVISIONS FOR EXISTING CONTRACTS; REPEALING ANY CONFLICTING PROVISIONS; AND PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAJOR AND COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN LUIS, ARIZONA:

**Section 1.** In order to repeal, rescind, replace and eliminate the exclusion of transactions with specified governmental agencies, Section 7A-280 of the Tax Code of the City of San Luis is hereby amended to read as follows: Section 7A-280 ( Reserved).

**Section 2.** The provisions of the ordinance relating to the privilege license tax of the City of San Luis will apply to existing contracts.

**Section 3.** In the event of a conflict between the provisions of this Ordinance and any other ordinance, code, resolution, regulation, or policy of the City of San Luis, the conflicting provisions are hereby repealed, superseded, and replaced.

**Section 4.** If any section, subsection, sentence, clause, phrase or portion of this ordinance is for any reason held to be invalid or unconstitutional by the decision of any court of competent jurisdiction, such shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions thereof.

**Section 5.** The effective date of the ordinance shall be thirty (30) days from the date of its passage and adoption by the City Council of the City of San Luis.
