ORDINANCE NO. 315

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN LUIS,
ARIZONA, REPEALING ORDINANCE NO. 191, AS AMENDED, RELATING TO
CERTAIN FEES FOR LAND USE APPLICATIONS AND RELATED
ADMINISTRATIVE FEES; SETTING AN EFFECTIVE DATE FOR REPEAL,
REPEALING ANY CONFLICTING PROVISIONS WITH RESOLUTION NO. 985; AND
PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY**

Whereas, fees for land use applications and related administrative fees were set by Ordinance No. 191, as amended, and have not been truly updated in the past ten years;

Whereas, the City Council of the City of San Luis during the past seven years, as a policy, has been generally establishing and setting municipal fees by resolution instead of by ordinance; and

Whereas, it is desired that Resolution No. 985 be the fee schedule that replaces Ordinance No. 191, as amended;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and City Council of the City of San Luis, Arizona, as follows:

Section 1: That Ordinance No. 191 of the City of San Luis, Arizona, as amended, relating to certain fees for land use applications and related administrative fees, is hereby repealed, subject to the conditions as set forth in Section 2 below.

Section 2: The repeal of Ordinance No. 191, as amended, shall not become effective until or unless Resolution No. 985 relating to certain land use fees and related administrative fees has been approved, adopted, and become effective.

Section 3: In the event of a conflict between the provisions of Resolution No. 985 and any other ordinance, resolution, regulation, or policy of the City of San Luis, the conflicting provisions are hereby repealed, superseded, and replaced, and the provisions of Resolution No. 985 shall govern.

Section 4: If any section, subsection, sentence, clause, phrase, or portion of this Ordinance is for any reason held to be invalid or unconstitutional by the final decision of any court of competent jurisdiction, such decision shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions of this Ordinance.


