AN ORDINANCE OF THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN LUIS, ARIZONA, AMENDING CHAPTER 112 THE TRANSPORTATION BUSINESS REGULATIONS OF THE CITY CODE OF THE CITY OF SAN LUIS, ARIZONA BY AMENDING SECTION 112.06 PERMIT TERMS AND FEES; SETTING EFFECTIVE DATE; REPEALING ANY CONFLICTING PROVISIONS, AND PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY

Whereas the City Council of the City of San Luis desires to clarify the regulation of the transportation business in the City of San Luis to recognize that the transportation business frequently uses independent contractor agreements and other contractual arrangements to actually operate vehicles doing business under a single operator's name, and the requirement of multiple business licenses can be both duplicative and confusing:

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and City Council of San Luis, Arizona, as follows:

Section 1: Section 112.06 of the City Code of the City of San Luis, Permit Terms and Fees, is hereby amended to add subsection 112.06 (C) as follows:


(C) If an operator of a vehicle has a business arrangement or other form of written agreement to operate a transportation business vehicle under the name of a business which has a business license issued pursuant to Chapter 110 of the City Code, said operator shall not be required to obtain another such business license pursuant to Chapter 110, and need only register the vehicle and pay the business vehicle license fee pursuant to this section.

Section 2: The effective date of this ordinance shall be January 1, 2014.

Section 3: In the event of a conflict between the provisions of this ordinance and any other ordinance, resolution, regulation, or policy of the City of San Luis, the conflicting provisions are hereby repealed, superseded, and replaced, and the provisions of this ordinance shall govern.

Section 4: If any section, subsection, sentence, phrase, clause or portion of this ordinance, or any part of the code adopted herein by reference is, for any reason, held to be invalid or unconstitutional by the decision of any court of competent jurisdiction, such decision shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions thereof.


