**AN ORDINANCE OF THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN LUIS, ARIZONA AMENDING THE SAN LUIS CITY CODE SECTION 152.047(D)(1) TO CHANGE THE SUBMITTAL DEADLINE FOR MAJOR GENERAL PLAN AMENDMENT APPLICATIONS; REPEALING ANY CONFLICTING PROVISIONS; AND PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY;**

**WHEREAS**, the current Major General Plan Amendment application deadline is June 15<sup>th</sup> of every year; and

**WHEREAS**, changing the application deadline will allow more time to process the application and any necessary requirements; and

**WHEREAS**, the City of San Luis ("City") desires to change the application deadline for Major General Plan Amendments to March 15<sup>th</sup> of every year;

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED** by the Mayor and City Council of the City of San Luis, Arizona, as follows:

**Section 1.** Subsections 152.047(D)(2) of the City Code regarding submittal deadline for Major General Plan Amendment applications, is hereby amended to read as follows:

(1)"A "major amendment" to the General Plan must be filed prior to March 15<sup>th</sup> of every year in order to be heard at the one City Council hearing designated each year to review major amendments to the General Plan. Major Amendments shall require an affirmative vote of at least two-thirds of the City Council."

**Section 2.** Providing for Repeal of Conflicting Ordinances.

All ordinances and parts of ordinances in conflict with the provisions of this ordinance or any part of the Code adopted herein by reference are hereby repealed.

**Section 3.** Providing for Severability.

If any section, subsection, sentence, clause, phrase or portion of this ordinance or any

part of the Code adopted herein by reference, is for any reason held to be invalid or unconstitutional by the decision of any court of competent jurisdiction, such decision shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions thereof.




