No. 415

An ordinance of the Mayor and City Council of the City of San Luis, Arizona, enacting a code of ordinances for the City of San Luis, revising, amending, restating, codifying and compiling certain existing general ordinances of the City of San Luis dealing with subjects embraced in such Code of Ordinances with Code Publishing Company; repealing any conflicting provision; providing for severability; and providing for penalties.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and City Council of the City of San Luis, Arizona, as follows:

Section 1. That certain document, known as the “Code of Ordinances for the City of San Luis,” three copies of which are on file in the Office of the City Clerk, of the City of San Luis, Arizona, which document was made a public record by Resolution No. 2175 of the City of San Luis, Arizona, is hereby referred to, incorporated, adopted and made a part hereof as if fully set out in this ordinance.

Section 2. By the adoption of this ordinance, the City Council hereby reaffirms that Ordinance Nos. 228, 409, 410, 411, 412, 413 and 415 have been an continue to be the law of the City of San Luis from the date of their adoption. Said ordinances shall continue to govern from and after the date of the adoption of this ordinance.

Section 3. Save and except the ordinances listed in Section 2 above, in the event of a conflict between the provisions of in the Code of Ordinances made a public record by Resolution No. 2175, and any other ordinance, code, resolution, regulation, or policy of the City of San Luis, the conflicting provisions are hereby repealed, superseded and replaced.

Section 4. If any section, subsection, sentence, clause, phrase or portion of this ordinance is for any reason held to be invalid or unconstitutional by the decision of any court of competent jurisdiction; such shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions thereof.
