AN ORDINANCE OF THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN LUIS, ARIZONA, AMENDING THE SAN LUIS CITY CODE; SECTION 5.15.090 OF THE CITY CODE, WHICH PROVIDES FOR A SYSTEM OF ISSUANCE AND REGULATION FOR BORDER AREA TAXI VEHICLE PERMITS AMENDING SUBSECTION 5.15.090(F) LIMITING THE NUMBER OF PERMITS TO ANY SINGLE BUSINESS; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE; REPEALING ANY CONFLICTING PROVISIONS; AND PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and City Council of the City of San Luis, Arizona, as follows:

Section 1: Subsection 5.15.090(F) of the City Code is hereby amended to read as follows:

No more than five (5) border area taxi vehicle permits shall be issued to any single taxicab business.

Section 2: For all border area taxi vehicle permits issued before the effective date of this ordinance, said permits shall be valid until the expiration date for said permit(s). The limits imposed by this ordinance shall only apply from and after the expiration of said issued permits. For all those applying for permits from and after the effective date of this ordinance, the limits imposed herein shall apply.

Section 3: In the event of a conflict between the provisions of this ordinance and any other ordinance, resolution, regulation, or policy of the City of San Luis, the conflicting provisions are hereby repealed, superseded, and replaced, and the provisions of this ordinance shall govern.

Section 4: If any section, subsection, sentence, clause, phrase or portion of this ordinance is for any reason held to be invalid or unconstitutional by the decision of any court of competent jurisdiction, such decision shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions thereof.


