

RESOLUTION NO. 5

RESOLUTION OF THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF SAN LUIS, YUMA COUNTY, STATE OF ARIZONA, AUTHORIZING THE TOWN MANAGER TO PROCEED WITH THE DRAFTING OF THE TOWN CODE FOR THE PURPOSE OF ESTABLISHING THE GUIDELINES RULES, AND REGULATIONS FOR THE OPERATION OF THE TOWN OF SAN LUIS; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the Town of San Luis is a newly incorporated municipal entity; and

WHEREAS, to date there does not exist a set of regulations or rules to govern or control the operation of the town administrative functions and other administrative related functions; and

WHEREAS, the Town Code is essential to determine the functions and responsibility of each elected official, appointed official, or department supervisors; and

WHEREAS, the Town of San Luis has to comply with the Arizona Revised Statute 9-303.

Now therefore, be it resolved by the Town Council of the Town of San Luis, Yuma County, State of Arizona as follows:


Section 1: The Town Council authorizes Jess Vela, Town Manager to proceed with the drafting of the Town Code.

Section 2: That the Town Manager prepares working drafts and presents final draft for adoption by the Town Council.


