

A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF SAN LUIS, YUMA COUNTY, STATE OF ARIZONA, ESTABLISHING THE DATE, TIME AND PLACE OF MEETINGS FOR THE PLANNING AND ZONING BOARD.

Whereas, the Town Council has adopted ordinance number 13, also known as the San Luis Zoning Code; and

Whereas, said ordinance was adopted for the promotion and protection of the public helath and to provide regulations for the future growth of the Town of San Luis; and

Whereas, a need for establishing a date, time and place for the Planning and Zoning Board to hold regular meetings.

NOW THEREFORE, be it resolved by the Town Council of the Town of San Luis, Yuma County, State of Arizona as follows:

Section 1

That the Planning and Zoning Board meet the third Wednesday of every month at 7:30 p.m. at the San Luis Town Hall with the option to call special meetings at the discretion of the Board Chairman.

Section 2


That all notices of said meetings be posted 24 hours prior to the scheduled time of the meeting.


Section 3
