

RESOLUTION No. 21

A RESOLUTION OF THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF SAN LUIS, YUMA COUNTY, STATE OF ARIZONA, ACKNOWLEDGING A TRANSFER OF TITLE AND DEED FROM YUMA COUNTY TO THE TOWN OF SAN LUIS, AND ACCEPTANCE OF THIS TRANSFER OF PROPERTY, KNOWN AS FRIENDSHIP PARK, BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF SAN LUIS, ARIZONA, FOR THE CONSIDERATION DESCRIBED HEREIN; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, The Board of Supervisors of Yuma County, Arizona, have voted on November 16, 1981, to transfer by title and deed property described as Township Eleven (11) South, Range Twenty-five (25) West, GSR Meridian, Arizona, Section Twelve (12), Lot Thirteen (13), also known as Friendship Park, and

WHEREAS, for the consideration described herein, of the sum of one dollar (\$ 1.00), to be paid to the Treasurer of Yuma County, State of Arizona, the San Luis Town Council agrees to acceptance of this property and deed recorded at the Yuma County Records Office on November 24, 1981.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF SAN LUIS, YUMA COUNTY, STATE OF ARIZONA, AS FOLLOWS, to wit:

Section 1 - Acceptance

The Town of San Luis does hereby accept this transfer of land known as Friendship Park from the County of Yuma, for and in consideration of the sum of one dollar (\$ 1.00), payable to the Treasurer of Yuma County.


Section 2 - Declaring An Emergency




