

RESOLUTION NO. 36

A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND COMMON COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF SAN LUIS, COUNTY OF YUMA, STATE OF ARIZONA, AUTHORIZING THE HOLDING OF A SPECIAL TOWN COUNCIL ELECTION ON DECEMBER 7TH, 1982, ESTABLISHING A POLLING PLACE AND VOTING DISTRICT; PROVIDING FOR THE RECORDATION OF THE ELECTOR'S CHOICE; MEANS OF APPOINTING ELECTION OFFICIALS AND FIXING THEIR COMPENSATION; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, it is provided by law for the holding of a Special Town Council Election in the Town of San Luis; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Town Council has by Proclamation called a Special Election to be held on December 7, 1982.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Mayor and Common Council of the Town of San Luis, Arizona as follows:

SECTION 1. Designation of Election Date

That the Town Council Special Election be held and conducted Tuesday, December 7th, 1982.

SECTION 2. Polling Place and Voting District

The polling place shall be the Town Hall of San Luis, Arizona located at 23222 First Street. The Voting District shall be the incorporated area of the Town of San Luis, Arizona.

The polls shall be open on said date of the San Luis Special Election from 6:00 a.m. until 7:00 p.m.

SECTION 3. Election Officials and Their Compensation

A list of Election Officials will be submitted to the Town Council by the Town Manager to be duly appointed by the Town Council within a reasonable time period from the passage of this Resolution, who will then conduct on said date the Special Election.

The compensation of each of the officers is fixed at the sum of \$3.35 per hour for the election; provided, that a minimum of \$20.00 per day must be paid to each such officer. If any member should fail to appear and serve, the Town Manager shall appoint a qualified substitute.

SECTION 4. Recordation of the Elector's Choice


Voting shall be by paper ballots. The Town Clerk is here by authorized and directed to cause the printing of paper ballots as set forth in Title 16, Chapter 5, Article 2, Arizona Revised Statutes, and Title 16, Chapter 7, Article 8, Arizona Revised Statutes.

SECTION 5. Declaring An Emergency

WHEREAS, the immediate operation of the provisions of this resolution is necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety of the Town of San Luis, Arizona, an emergency is hereby declared to exist; and this resolution shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, adoption and approval by the Mayor and Common Council of the Town of San Luis, Arizona, and it is hereby exempt from the referendum provision of the Constitution and laws of the State of Arizona.

PASSED AND ADOPTED by the Mayor and Common Council of the Town of San Luis, Arizona, this 27 day of OCTOBER 1982.




