

RESOLUTION NO. 52

A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWN COUNCIL, TOWN OF
SAN LUIS, YUMA COUNTY, STATE OF ARIZONA,
AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 3, RELATED TO THE
INTEREST AND PENALTIES TO IMPOSED BE IMPOSED
BY THE STATE REVENUE DEPARTMENT.

GENERAL SECTION I

WHEREAS, Notwithstanding any other provisions of this resolution to the contrary, taxes shall be due, payable and delinquent on the dates specified in Section 43-1322 of Arizona Revised Statutes for collection of the state transaction privilege tax. Interest and penalties shall be charged at the same rate and at the same time as provided in Section 43-1322 and 42-1327 of Arizona Revised Statutes as amended by HB 2003 for the state transaction privilege tax.

SECTION II

NOW, THEREFORE, be it resolved by the Town Council of San Luis, Arizona, Yuma County as follows:

SECTION III

That all changes related to imposed penalties be complied with by the Town of San Luis as per fluctuations of State Sales Tax Revenue Laws.

SECTION IV EMERGENCY CLAUSE


