

A RESOLUTION OF THE SAN LUIS TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF SAN LUIS, YUMA COUNTY, ARIZONA, RECOGNIZING WESTERN ARIZONA EMERGENCY MEDICAL SERVICES COUNCIL AS THE LOCAL EMERGENCY MEDICAL SERVICE COORDINATING SYSTEM IN ACCORDANCE WITH ARIZONA REVISED STATUTES SECTION 36-2210.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF TOWN OF SAN LUIS AS FOLLOWS:

WHEREAS, WESTERN ARIZONA EMERGENCY MEDICAL SERVICES currently plans and coordinates regional services within the Western Arizona EMS Region; and

WHEREAS, WESTERN ARIZONA EMERGENCY MEDICAL SYSTEM has established the Western Arizona Emergency Medical Services Council to plan and coordinate regional emergency medical services within Yuma, LaPaz and Mohave Counties; and

WHEREAS, WESTERN ARIZONA EMERGENCY MEDICAL SERVICES, has a governing Board made up of local elected officials WAEMSC providing input from providers, consumers and elected officials;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF SAN LUIS AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. That Western Arizona Emergency Medical Services Council is recognized as the local emergency medical service coordinating system for Yuma, LaPaz and Mohave Counties under the requirements of Arizona Revised Statutes, Section 41-1849.

SECTION 2. That Western Arizona Emergency Medical Services Council is authorized and required to provide assistance, including planning, coordinating and financial assistance for programs and projects affecting local governments within the Western Arizona EMS Region.

SECTION 3. That this endorsement shall not constitute an authorization for expenditure of Town funds without further action of the San Luis Town Council.
