

A RESOLUTION RECOMMENDING TO THE ARIZONA CORPORATION COMMISSION DENIAL OF AN IN-STATE ACCESS CHARGE FOR THE TELEPHONE COMPANY.

WHEREAS, the current cost for telephone services is a substantial portion of the operating budget; and

WHEREAS, the resources of government entities are increasingly more scarce; and


WHEREAS, it is in the best interest of the taxpayers to hold down operating costs by recommending to the Arizona Corporation Commission denial of the proposed in-state access charge; and

WHEREAS, the "access" charge is not optional and will be added to the cost of such services as MCI and Sprint;

NOW, THEREFORE, be it resolved by the Council of the Town of San Luis as follows:



PASSED AND ADOPTED by the Council and approved by the Mayor of the Town of San Luis this 23rd day of November, 1983.




