A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF SAN LUIS ARIZONA, YUMA COUNTY, SUPPORTING BILL 41-70 INTRODUCED BY STATE REPRESENTATIVE MARTIN FROST, DEMOCRAT-TEXAS, TO THE UNITED STATES HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES.

PASSED AND ADOPTED by the Mayor and Town Council of the Town of San Luis, Arizona, this 8th day of February, 1984.




