

RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND COMMON COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF SAN LUIS, COUNTY OF YUMA, STATE OF ARIZONA GIVING THE SAN LUIS ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT COMMISSION CONTROL AND AUTHORITY OVER THE SAN LUIS INDUSTRIAL PARK.

THAT no lease be executed for the Industrial Park until reviewed by the San Luis Economic Development Commission and the Planning and Zoning Board.


THAT the San Luis Economic Development Commission- establish rules and guidelines for commercial zoning requirements and industrial site standards which are to be defined for inclusion in any leases to be executed.

FURTHERMORE, That the Council consider giving the San Luis Economic Development Commission all management authority of the San Luis Industrial Park.

THAT the San Luis Economic Development Commission establish the development of applications, guidelines and standards for the acceptance and approval of any sub-leasee for the San Luis Industrial Park. This would prevent any legal conflicts that could arise from the lack of control and supervision.

FURTHERMORE, that the Industrial Park should have a definite zoning designation with guidelines to be established by the San Luis Economic Development Commission



