

A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF SAN LUIS, REQUESTING THE ARIZONA DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION TO AUTHORIZE TRANSPORTATION ASSISTANCE FUNDS PURSUANT TO SECTION 40-1102, ARIZONA REVISED STATUTES.

WHEREAS, the Thirty-fifth Legislature, second special session of 1981 established a Local Transportation Assistance Fund from proceeds of the Arizona State Lottery; and

WHEREAS, the Director of the Arizona Department of Transportation shall determine the total amount of requests for Local Transportation Funds from Cities and Towns; and


WHEREAS, these funds are to be distributed on a monthly basis by the State Treasurer to Cities and Towns requesting funds; and

WHEREAS, these funds are to be used for the following purposes:


1. Street improvements and related uses.
2. 10% of funds will be used for cultural and recreational purposes.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Mayor and Town Council of the Town of San Luis, Arizona, that the Arizona Department of Transportation is hereby requested to take necessary steps in authorizing Local Transportation Assistance Funds for the above-mentioned purposes.


