

A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF SAN LUIS, ARIZONA, IDENTIFYING COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT AND HOUSING NEEDS AND ACTIVITIES TO BE UNDERTAKEN TO MEET SUCH NEEDS.


WHEREAS, Title 1 of the Housing And Community Development Act of 1974, as amended through the Housing And Urban-Rural Recovery Act of 1983, states that the primary objective of the Title and of the Community Development Program of each grantee is the "development of viable urban communities by providing decent housing and a suitable living environment and expanding economic opportunities, principally for persons of low and moderate income..."; and

WHEREAS, Section 106(d)(2)(D) requires the Governor of each state to certify that each unit of general local government to be distributed funds will identify its community development and housing needs, including the needs of low and moderate income persons, and the activities to be undertaken to meet such needs.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT the Mayor and Town Council of the Town of San Luis, Arizona, hereby state that the greatest community development and housing need of the Town of San Luis, Arizona including the needs of low and moderate income persons is: Increased and better employment opportunities for San Luis, Arizona residents.

AND BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED THAT the Mayor and Council of the Town of San Luis, Arizona, hereby state that the activity proposed to be undertaken to meet such needs are: Preparing the Industrial Park area by putting in the off-site improvements, in order to attract viable industry which will offer employment to Town residents on a priority basis.


