RESOLUTION FOR THE ADOPTION OF THE BUDGET  
FISCAL YEAR 1984-85


WHEREAS, in accordance with the provisions of Title 42 Section 301, 302, 303 and 304, A.R.S., the Town Council did, on the July 16, 1984, make an estimate of the different amounts required to meet the public expenses for the ensuing year, also an estimate of revenues from sources other than direct taxation within the Town of San Luis, Arizona.

WHEREAS, in accordance with said section of said title, and following due public notice, the Council met on July 16, 1984, at which meeting any taxpayer was privileged to appear and be heard in favor of or against any of the proposed expenditures or tax levies, and


WHEREAS, it appears that the sums to be raised by primary taxation, as specified therein, do not in the aggregate amount exceed that amount as computed in Title 42 Section 301.A A.R.S.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the said estimates of revenue and expenditures shown on the accompanying schedules as now increased, reduced or changed by and the same are hereby adopted as the budget of the Town of San Luis for the fiscal year 1984-85.


