WHEREAS, current emergency medical and ambulance service is provided by Rural Metro out of Yuma; and,


WHEREAS, current ambulance response time is over 30 minutes to San Luis; and,

WHEREAS, such an ambulance would not only serve the Somerton area, but through an agreement, the San Luis area too, reducing ambulance response time.




