RESOLUTION NO. 98

RESOLUTION REQUESTING STATE LAND DEPARTMENT TO WITHDRAW SOME 30.9 ACRES OF STATE LAND FROM THE URBAN LAND ACT.

WHEREAS, the Town of San Luis, Arizona is the legal municipal entity situated adjacent to 1,200 acres of State Lands which have been included in the State Urban Lands Act coverage; and,

WHEREAS, the purpose of the Urban Lands Act is to insure proper appropriate development of State Lands in concert with local municipal plans and designs; and,

WHEREAS, a private developer wishes to construct an R.V. Park on 30.9 acres of State land adjacent to San Luis; and,

WHEREAS, said R.V. Park development will be in complete accordance with the Town's Master Plan and development design for that 30.9 acres.


THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Mayor and Council of the Town of San Luis, Arizona that the 30.9 acres, as identified in the attached legal description, be withdrawn from the State Urban Lands Act coverage, and thereby made available for lease to the public under less time consuming constraints.

PASSED AND ADOPTED by the Mayor and Town Council of the Town of San Luis, Arizona this 22nd day of May, 1985.




