A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN LUIS, ARIZONA PROVIDING FOR COMPLIANCE WITH A.R.S. §16-204 AS AMENDED BY THE ARIZONA STATE LEGISLATURE IN 2012 IN EXTENDING THE TERMS OF MEMBERS OF COUNCIL TO COMPLY WITH THE CHANGE IN CITY ELECTION DATES.

WHEREAS, the Arizona State Legislature in 2012 amended A.R.S. §16-204 to consolidate all regular candidate elections including those of the City of San Luis, Arizona to the Fall of even numbered years; and

WHEREAS, this new law becomes effective on January 1, 2014; and

WHEREAS, this new law requires adjusting the length of terms of the mayor and members of the council currently serving in office so that their terms will expire following the general election in November of even numbered years;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Mayor and Council of the City of San Luis, Arizona as follows:

Section 1: The term of the mayor will expire following the canvass of the general election in November 2014.

Section 2: The term of any member of the council with two or fewer years left in their council term will expire following the canvass of the general election in November 2014.

Section 3: The term of any member of the council with two or more years left in their council term will expire following the canvass of the general election in November 2016.

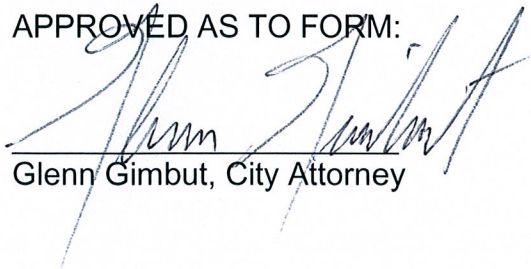
