

A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND TOWN COUNCIL
OF THE TOWN OF SAN LUIS ADOPTING A PLAN TO
MINIMIZE DISPLACEMENT AND ASSIST PERSONS
ACTUALLY DISPLACED AS A RESULT OF ACTIVITIES
FUNDED IN WHOLE OR IN PART WITH 1985 COM-
MUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT FUNDS.

WHEREAS, the Housing and Community Development Act of 1974, as amended by the Urban-Rural Recovery Act of 1983, Section 104(a)(2)(A) and Section 104(j), requires that all recipients of Community Development Block Grant funds develop plans to minimize displacement and to assist persons actually displaced as a result of activities funded in whole or in part with CDBG funds; and

WHEREAS, the State of Arizona, Office of Economic Planning and Development, has developed a strategy, recordkeeping requirements and resource materials to implement such a plan,


NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Mayor and Town Council of the Town of San Luis, Az. hereby adopt a strategy to minimize displacement and agree to document all such efforts; certify that the Town of San Luis will not initiate any displacement activity until a source and specific amount of funds to provide assistance and reasonable benefits to those displaced has been identified and approved by OEPAD; name (identify person or persons) to be responsible for providing counseling and assistance to those displaced, should such actions be necessary, and adopt the strategy, recordkeeping requirements and informational procedures recommended by OEPAD to insure that assistance and reasonable benefits are provided to those displaced.


