

RESOLUTION NO. 114

A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF SAN LUIS, ARIZONA DESIGNATING THE YUMA METROPOLITAN PLANNING ORGANIZATION TO PROVIDE ASSISTANT FOR THE PURPOSE OF OBTAINING A 911 SYSTEM.

WHEREAS, the Town Council of the Town of San Luis considers it desirable to have the Emergency 911 System; and

WHEREAS, funds are available in the emergency Telecommunication Services Revolving Fund for communities desiring to obtain 911 service; and

WHEREAS, it is necessary to designate an Official Town Representative to deal derectly with other jurisdictions in the Yuma area desirous of obtaining a 911 System and to deal directly with Mountain Bell and the Arizona Department of Administration;

WHEREAS, it is necessary to provide any emergency response 911 System that can also meet the needs of the Spanish-Speaking as well;

NOW THEREFORE, be it resolved by the Town Council of the Town of San Luis, Arizona as follow:




