A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF SAN LUIS, YUMA COUNTY, ARIZONA SUPPORTING UTILIZATION OF A LIBRARY DISTRICT BY THE COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS FOR THE PURPOSE OF OPERATING A YUMA COUNTY COUNTY LIBRARY SYSTEM FINANCED BY A COUNTY-WIDE SECONDARY PROPERTY TAX

WHEREAS, public library services are considered essential to the educational and cultural well-being of the community; and,


WHEREAS, the existence of good quality services contributes significantly to the economic growth and development of the community as well as contributing to the quality of life; and,

WHEREAS, the public library is unique in that it serves people of all ages and conditions from pre-schooler to senior citizen and functions as an all encompassing, non-discriminatory life-long learning center; and,

WHEREAS, the maintenance and promotion of a quality public library system depends upon a stable, reliable, and equitable funding source that increases with population growth and developmnet; and,




