

RESOLUTION NO. 127

A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWN COUNCIL OF SAN LUIS, YUMA COUNTY, ARIZONA, HEREBY REQUESTING STATE LAND DEPARTMENT AUTHORIZATION TO ANNEX STATE LAND CONTIGUOUS TO THE BOUNDARIES OF THE TOWN OF SAN LUIS.


WHEREAS, it is the intent of the Town of San Luis to provide a positive influence over the properly planned and managed development occurring on state land contiguous to the Town's corporate limits; and,

WHEREAS, the planned and managed development of the proposed annexed state lands can be better coordinated with the State Land Department if said state lands are within the corporate limits of the Town of San Luis; and,

WHEREAS, the state land to be annexed, more fully described in the attached legal description and map, has increasing commercial, residential and industrial development potential if it is within the corporate limits of the Town of San Luis, and in accordance with the State's Urban Land Act.




