

RESOLUTION NO. 128

A RESOLUTION OF THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF SAN LUIS, YUMA COUNTY, ARIZONA, OPPOSING THE PASSAGE OF SENATE BILL S.1349 PRESENTLY PENDING CONSIDERATION AND HEARING BEFORE THE ARIZONA SENATE FINANCE COMMITTEE.

WHEREAS, there is presently pending before the Arizona Senate Finance Committee Senate Bill S.1349 which has as its purpose the removal of substantial taxing authority from the cities and towns of the State of Arizona; and

WHEREAS, the Common Council of the Town of San Luis after due consideration of the provisions of said proposed bill believe it to be inimical to the interests of the Town of San Luis and all cities and towns in the State of Arizona;

NOW THEREFORE, be it resolved by the Mayor and Common Council of the Town of San Luis, Arizona as follows:



PASSED AND ADOPTED by the Common Council and approved by the Mayor of the Town of San Luis, Arizona this 25th day of March, 1987.




