

RESOLUTION NO. 146

A RESOLUTION BY THE MAYOR AND TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF SAN LUIS, ARIZONA, SUPPORTING WESTERN ARIZONA EMERGENCY MEDICAL SERVICES ACTIVITIES.

WHEREAS, the Western Arizona Emergency Medical Services is required by the State to solicit support from counties and incorporated cities within its region in order to insure that WAEMS will continue to plan and coordinate the regional EMS system within its designated planning area; and

WHEREAS, WAEMS acts as a designate agency for certain medical services grants; and

WHEREAS, this support incurs no obligations on the part of the Council; and

WHEREAS, the Town of San Luis desires to keep active with this program;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Town Council of the Town of San Luis, Arizona, supports the Western Arizona Emergency Medical Services Council, a private non-profit corporation serving Mohave, La Paz and Yuma Counties and their incorporated cities.


