

RESOLUTION NO. 149

A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF SAN LUIS, ARIZONA SUPPORTING THE REVITALIZATION OF THE LAND AND WATER CONSERVATION FUND (LWCF) AND ENCOURAGING THE SUPPORT OF LEGISLATION SPONSORED BY U.S. CONGRESSMAN THE HONORABLE MORRIS K. UDALL ASSURING THE CONTINUANCE OF SUCH AN IMPORTANT FUND.

WHEREAS, the Town of San Luis having been the recipient of funds in the amount of \$32,534.50 that were used to improve Friendship Park, our only recreational facility at the time; and

WHEREAS, the Town of San Luis is desirous of undertaking future recreational activities and projects within the scope of LWCF Programs; and

WHEREAS, the Town of San Luis feels such progress has been instrumental in the development of past and future activities improving the quality of life of the town and its residents.

NOW THEREFORE, be it resolved that the Town Council of the Town of San Luis, Arizona fully supports the revitalization of the Land and Water Conservation Fund (LWCF) and encourage support of legislation sponsored by U.S. Congressman the Honorable Morris K. Udall assuring the continuance and revitalization of such an important program.


