A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING PARTICIPATION IN THE "RURAL ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT DEMONSTRATION" PROGRAM.

WHEREAS, the Arizona Rural Economic Development Demonstration Program has been created by the Arizona State Legislature to assist rural communities and areas to develop a public-private effort to promote and enhance economic development and three communities/ areas will be selected to participate in the program in 1988; and


WHEREAS, the Town of San Luis desires to participate in the Arizona Rural Economic Development Demonstration Program;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE Mayor and Council representing the Town of San Luis apply for selection to participate in the Arizona Rural Economic Development Demonstration Program with the specific goal of developing local initiatives to strengthen and diversify its economic base.

SECTION I. THAT UPON SELECTION TO THE PROGRAM, THE Town of San Luis will follow all State of Arizona Rural Economic Development Demonstration Program procedures which include hiring a full-time local coordinator and committing to participate in the program for three years.

SECTION II. THAT THE Town of San Luis understands that the Rural Economic Development Demonstration program is a three year program funded locally with seed money for the first year through the state.


