RESOLUTION FOR THE FINAL ADOPTION OF THE BUDGET
FISCAL YEAR 1988-89

WHEREAS, in accordance with the provisions of Title 42, Section 301, 302, 303 and 304, A.R.S., the San Luis Town Council did, on the June 29th., 1988, make an estimate of the different amounts required to meet the public expenses for the ensuing year, also an estimate of revenues from sources other than direct taxation, and the amount to be raised taxation upon real and personal property within the Town of San Luis, and


WHEREAS, in accordance with said sections of said title, and following due public notice, the San Luis Town Council met on Aug. 1st., 1988, at which meeting any taxpayer was privileged to appear and be heard in favor of or against any of the proposed expenditures or tax levies, and

WHEREAS, it appears that publication has been duly made as required by law, of said estimates together with a notice that the San Luis Town Council would meet on Aug. 1st., 1988, at the office of the San Luis Town Council for the purpose of making tax levies as set forth in said estimates, as

WHEREAS, it appears that the sums to be raised by primary taxation, as specified therein, do not in the aggregate amount exceed that amount as computed in Title 42, Section 301.A A.R.S., therefore be it

RESOLVED, that the said estimates of revenue and expenditure shown on the accompanying schedules as now increased, reduced or changed by and the same are hereby adopted as the budget of the Town of San Luis, for the Fiscal Year of 1988-89.

Passed by the San Luis Town Council, this 1st., day of July 1988.







The Town of San Luis also hereby approves and consents to the transfer of the controlling interest in Yuma Cablevision, Inc., a Texas corporation, from Adam to AdamBanc Savings Association, and, thereafter, to Century Cable of Northern California, a California corporation, its wholly-owned subsidiary, or a general partnership of which it or its wholly-owned subsidiary is a general partner. Yuma Cablevision, Inc. will remain the assignee of the non-exclusive license to operate a cable television system within the Town of San Luis granted by the License Agreement dated July 1, 1983, and assigned to Adam by Resolution No. 145.
