



RESOLUTION NO. 162

A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF SAN LUIS, COUNTY OF YUMA, STATE OF ARIZONA, SUPPORTING ARIZONA'S PROPOSAL TO BE THE SITE OF THE SUPERCONDUCTING SUPER COLLIDER (SSC) PROJECT.

WHEREAS, on December 29, 1987, the State of Arizona was notified that it had been selected as one of the eight finalists in the competition for the federal Superconducting Super Collider (SSC) Project; and

WHEREAS, on January 19, 1988, the Department of Energy formally announced that Arizona had been selected as a finalist; and


WHEREAS, the site selected by the National Academy of Sciences and the National Academy of Engineering ("NAS/NAE") is the one located 35 miles southwest of Phoenix and will become known as the Arizona Site; and


WHEREAS, Arizona stands on the verge of national and international recognition as the ideal host for the Superconducting Super Collider (SSC) Project.
