

RESOLUTION NO. 171


A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN LUIS, ARIZONA, SETTING THE TERM FOR THE OFFICE OF MAYOR TO BE ELECTED DIRECTLY BY THE QUALIFIED ELECTORS.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN LUIS:

That Article 2-1-1 Elected Officials of the City Code of San Luis, sets forth that the mayor shall be elected directly by the qualified electors of the City of San Luis and that the term of office shall be governed by such resolutions as the Council may adopt.


That the term of office for the Mayor, commencing with the May, 1990 election, shall be for a term of Four (4) years.


