

RESOLUTION NO. 175

A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN LUIS, ARIZONA, COUNTY OF YUMA, SUPPORTING THE CITY OF SIERRA VISTA OPPOSING THE CLOSING OF FORT HUACHUCA BASE.

WHEREAS, On December 29, 1988, the Base Closure and Realignment Commission announced the results of its findings; and

WHEREAS, part of its findings was the relocation of the Information Systems Commands from Fort Huachuca, Arizona to Fort Devens, Massachusetts; and

WHEREAS, after a great deal of investigation, it has been determined that this move does not comport to the letter or the intention of the Base Closure and Realignment Act; and

WHEREAS, in an era of emphasis on economic development, the State of Arizona stands to lose a 500 million dollar industry. Furthermore, this represents approximately 30 million dollars to state and local governments.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Mayor and City Council of the City of San Luis supports the City of Sierra Vista opposing the closing of Fort Huachuca Base.


