RESOLUTION FOR THE FINAL ADOPTION OF THE BUDGET

WHEREAS, in accordance with the provisions of Title 42, Section 301, 302, 303 and 304, A.R.S., the San Luis City Council did, on the June 26, 1989, make an estimate of the different amounts required to meet the public expenses for the ensuing year, also an estimate of revenues from sources other than direct taxation, and the amount to be raised taxation upon real and personal property within the City of San Luis, and


WHEREAS, in accordance with said sections of said title, and following due public notice, the San Luis City Council met in Aug. 9, 1989, at which meeting any taxpayer was previledged to appear and be heard in favor of or against any of the proposed expenditures or tax levies, and

WHEREAS, it appears that publication has been duly made as required by law, of said estimates together with a notice that the San Luis City Council would meet on Aug. 9, 1989, at the office of the San Luis City Council for the purpose of making tax levies as set forth in said estimates, as

WHEREAS, it appears that the sums to be raised by primary taxation, as specified therein, do not in the aggregate amount exceed that amount as computed intitle 42, Section 301, A.R.S., therefore be it

RESOLVED, that the said estimates of revenue and expenditure shown on the accompanying schedules as now increased, reduced or changed by and the same are hereby adopted as the budget of the City of San Luis, for the Fiscal Year of 1989-1990.






