

A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF  
CITY OF SAN LUIS ADOPTING A PLAN TO MINIMIZE  
DISPLACEMENT AND ASSIST PERSONS ACTUALLY DISPLACED  
AS A RESULT OF ACTIVITIES FUNDED IN WHOLE OR IN  
PART WITH 1989 COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT  
FUNDS.

WHEREAS, Title I of the Housing and Community Development Act of 1974, as amended through the Housing and Urban-Rural Recovery Act of 1983, states that the primary objective of the Title and of the Community development program of each grantee is the "development of viable urban communities by providing decent housing and a suitable living environment and expanding economic opportunities, principally for persons of low and moderate income..."; and

WHEREAS, Section 106 (d) (2) (D) requires the Governor of each state to certify that each unit of general local government to be distributed funds will identify its community development and housing needs, including the needs of low and moderate income persons, and the activities to be undertaken to meet such needs.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Mayor and City Council of the City of San Luis, Az. hereby adopt a strategy to minimize displacement and agree to document all such efforts; certify that the City of San Luis, will not initiate any displacement activity until a source and specific amount of funds to provide assistance and reasonable benefits to those displaced has been identified and approved by OEPAD, name (identify person or persons) to be responsible for providing counseling and assistance to those displaced, should such actions be necessary, and adopt the strategy, recordkeeping requirements and informational procedures recommended by OEPAD to insure that assistance and reasonable benefits are provided to those displaced.


