RESOLUTION NO. 185

A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN LUIS, ARIZONA, AUTHORIZING AND ENDORSING THE SUBMISSION OF AN APPLICATION FOR STATE DEVELOPMENT FUNDS FOR 1990.

WHEREAS, the City of San Luis has committed resources, staff and continued funding to fostering and supporting a full-time economic development department, and has participated successfully in the REDI program; and,

WHEREAS, the City of San Luis is committed to the continuing development of the San Luis Industrial Complex in order to continue to foster job creation opportunities for San Luis residents; and,


WHEREAS, the City of San Luis desires to continue the momentum attained with the completion of the Industrial Complex Master Plan, completed with the assistance of the Arizona Department of Commerce and the 1989 State Development Funds; and,

WHEREAS, the City of San Luis recognizes the importance of continued funding for the purposes of completing the next phase in the improvement of the Industrial Complex, to consist of the completion of fully engineered construction plans for the infrastructure improvements needed in the Industrial Complex; and,

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Mayor and City Council of the City of San Luis, Arizona, the City of San Luis authorizes application be made to the State of Arizona, Department of Commerce, to seek continued funding for the purposes of completing engineered construction plans for the San Luis Industrial Complex; and this resolution shall be effective immediately upon its passage and adoption.


