BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND THE CITY COUNCIL OF SAN LUIS, ARIZONA,


THAT Section 2-4-6 of the City Code of San Luis, Arizona, authorizes the
commissions of the City of San Luis to set fees that are set by resolution.

THAT the San Luis Economic Development Commission is a commission authorized
by the City of San Luis and is desirous of charging reasonable fees for specific
services and filing costs.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the San Luis Economic Development
Commission is authorized to charge the following additional fees incident
to the development and operation of the San Luis Industrial Complex:


1. An application filing fee for each tenant of \$200 of any approved
lessee. The filing fee is a non-refundable fee which is charged
on the submission of the application for approval of the tenant.
2. Various filing fees as required by the State Land Department
of the State of Arizona, to include but is not limited to: Submission
of leases or subleases for recording; Applications to Place Improvements;
amendments to existing leases; Report of Improvements Placed; and
shall be set according to the current fees charged by the State Land
Department and billed to each lessee accordingly by written invoice.
Filing fees are non-refundable fees.
