A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN LUIS, ARIZONA, COUNTY OF YUMA, DECLARING OCTOBER 22ND-29TH, 1989 "DRUG FREE WEEK" IN CONJUNCTION WITH ARIZONA DRUG FREE WEEK.

WHEREAS, we want our community to know how much we desire to eradicate this problem from our streets and protect our men and women of tomorrow.


