RESOLUTION No. 190

A Resolution of the Mayor and Common Council of the City of San Luis, Arizona, recommending the site location for a proposed new Arizona Department of Transportation port-of-entry to be located in the vicinity of, or within, City limits, in order to better regulate commercial truck carriers and accomodate future growth plans.

WHEREAS, the City of San Luis has been actively involved in master planning the community; and,

WHEREAS, the City of San Luis is experiencing dramatic growth in residential, commercial and industrial areas; and,

WHEREAS, the City of San Luis has been proactively planning for and addressing the many issues related to the consequences of this significant growth, and endorses the philosophy of directing growth and development through solid planning, with foresight; and,

WHEREAS, it is the intent of the City to facilitate compatible uses and incorporates this philosophy into the planning efforts, taking into consideration the needs of residential neighborhoods, commercial districts, industrial development, traffic congestion, future growth patterns, transportation issues, city and other government services, etc.; and,

WHEREAS, the City of San Luis actively and regularly participates in transportation planning organizations and issues, at both the local and regional levels, and is anticipating transportation needs for the community in the immediate and distant future; and,

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN LUIS,

FOR ALL THE REASONS SET FORTH ABOVE, THE MAYOR AND COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN LUIS URGE THE ARIZONA DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION TO PLAN FOR AND LOCATE A NEW PORT-OF-ENTRY, INCLUDING OFFICES AND TRUCK SCALES, AT THE VICINITY OF EIGHTH STREET AND CITY "G" STREET TO FACILITATE ACCESS ONTO U.S. HIGHWAY 95 AND THE COUNTY 23RD TRUCK ROUTE.
