

RESOLUTION NO. 194

A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN LUIS, ARIZONA, PROVIDING NOTICE OF THE REGULAR PRIMARY ELECTION; ESTABLISHING POLLING PLACES AND VOTING DISTRICTS AND TIMES THAT SUCH POLLS WILL BE OPEN; AND APPOINTING ELECTION OFFICIALS AND FIXING THEIR COMPENSATION.

WHEREAS, it is provided by law for the holding of a Primary Election; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Council has called for a Primary Election to be held on March 20, 1990.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Mayor and Council of the City of San Luis, Arizona as follows:

SECTION 1. DESIGNATION OF ELECTION DATE

That the City Primary Election be held on Tuesday, March 20, 1990 for the purpose of nominating/electing candidates for the offices of Mayor and Council Members. Any candidates receiving a majority of all of the votes cast at the Primary Election will be declared elected without running at the General Municipal Election.

A proposal to adopt a local alternative expenditure limitation - home rule option will be considered at the City of San Luis Primary Election on Tuesday, March 20, 1990.

SECTION 2. POLLING PLACES AND VOTING DISTRICTS

The polling place shall be the City Hall of San Luis, Arizona located at 23222 First Street. The voting district shall be the incorporated area of the City of San Luis, Arizona. The polls shall be open on said date of the San Luis Primary Election from 6:00 A.M. until 7:00 P.M.

SECTION 3. ELECTION OFFICIALS AND THEIR COMPENSATION


A list of Election Officials will be submitted to the City Council by the City Manager to be duly appointed by the City Council within a reasonable time period from the passage of this resolution who will then conduct on said date the Primary Election. The compensation of each of the officers is fixed at the sum of \$3.75 per hour for the election; provided that a minimum of \$25.00 per day must be paid to each such officer. If any member should fail to appear and serve, the City Manager shall appoint a qualified substitute.
