A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN LUIS, ARIZONA APPROVING AND ADOPTING DEVELOPMENT FEES; DECLARING IT A PUBLIC RECORD, ESTABLISHING AN EFFECTIVE DATE; REPEALING ANY CONFLICTING PROVISIONS; AND PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Mayor and City Council of the City of San Luis, Arizona, as follows:

Section 1. The document titled “Land Use Assumptions, Infrastructure Improvements Plan, and Development Fee Report” dated October 2, 2019, is incorporated by this reference and made a part of the development fees of the City of San Luis, as though fulling set out again in full.

Section 2. Said document, three (3) copies of which are on file in the office of the City Clerk, is hereby declared to be a public record and said copies are ordered to remain on file with the City Clerk.


Section 3. The effective date of the development fees shall be December 16, 2019.



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
