A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN LUIS, ARIZONA, AUTHORIZING THE SUBMISSION OF AN APPLICATION TO THE UNITED STATES DEPARTMENT OF INTERIOR, BUREAU OF LAND MANAGEMENT TO ACQUIRE FEDERAL RIGHT OF WAY LAND FOR THE WIDENING OF CESAR CHAVEZ BOULEVARD.

WHEREAS, the Bureau of Land Management requires state or local governments to provide authorization to submit an application to the Bureau of Land Management; and

WHEREAS, the City of San Luis requires the federal right of way lands to widen Cesar Chavez Boulevard; and

WHEREAS, the City of San Luis wishes to submit a transportation and utility systems and facilities on federal lands application; and

WHEREAS, said lands owned by the Bureau of Land Management are a part of:

Section 3, 4, 5, 8 and 9, Township 11 South, Range 24 West, Gila and Salt River Meridian,

and

Section 1 and 12, Township 11 South, Range 25 West, Gila and Salt River Meridian

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Mayor and Council of the City of San Luis, Arizona, that they hereby authorize the submission of an application for right of way land located South of Avenue E and authorize the City Manager to sign the resulting documents.




