

RESOLUTION NO. 201

A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF CITY OF SAN LUIS, YUMA COUNTY, ARIZONA, DECLARING AND ADOPTING THE RESULTS OF THE PRIMARY ELECTION HELD ON MARCH 20, 1990; AND ORDERING THE RECORDING OF SUCH RESOLUTION.

WHEREAS, the City of San Luis, Yuma County, Arizona by Resolution No. 194 adopted on the 22nd. day of February, 1990, did cause to be submitted to the qualified electors of the City at a Primary Election called and held in an for the City on the 20th. day of March, 1990 for the election of a Mayor and three Council Members and

WHEREAS, the City Council did cause of the Primary Election to be given by the City Clerk publishing notice therof in the Yuma Daily Sun newspaper as provided by law, such newspaper published in an having general circulation within said City, which said notice as so published did specify the place whereat such election was to be held, and the candidates to be voted upon, copy of said notice with the affidavit of publication attached thereto, being now on file and part of the official records of the City Council of said City and

WHEREAS, the election returns have been presented to and have been canvassed by the City Council.

NOW THEREOF, BE IT RESOLVED by the Mayor and Council of the City of San Luis, Yuma County, Arizona as follows:

SECTION 1. That the total numbers of ballots cast at said Primary Election, as shown by the poll lists, was 248.

SECTION 2. That the numbers of rejected ballots was 1, and that voters found ineligible were 5.

SECTION 3. That the votes cast for the candidates for Council Member were as follows:

SECTION 4. That the votes cast for the candidate of Mayor were as follows:

Martina M. Lopez




