

RESOLUTION NO. 202

A RESOLUTION REQUESTING THE COUNTY OF YUMA TO ASSIST IN PROVIDING THE CITY OF SAN LUIS WITH A PROPER VOTER REGISTRATION ROLL.

WHEREAS, the City of San Luis is a body politic located within the County of Yuma, and

WHEREAS, the City of San Luis is required under A.R.S. §9-823 and §16-172 to use registration lists provided by the County of Yuma, and

WHEREAS, the integrity of the voting process is basic to our form of government and a proper voting list is a cornerstone of the voting process, and

WHEREAS, the City of San Luis has been advised that there may be as many as twenty to thirty voters on said registration list who were not qualified to vote, and

WHEREAS, litigation has resulted from allegations of improper voting, which includes improper voters being included on the voter roll,

WHEREAS, the County of Yuma has not relayed to the City of San Luis the reasons for those disqualified voters appearing on the roll, and

WHEREAS, the City of San Luis believes that the County of Yuma is obligated to provide the City of San Luis with a list that does not knowingly contain improper voters, and

WHEREAS, the County of Yuma is a proper person, under the provisions of A.R.S. §16-167, to compel cancellation of improper registrations.

NOW, THEREFORE, be it resolved by the Mayor and Council of the City of San Luis, Arizona that: (1) the County of Yuma is requested to provide the City of San Luis with a roll devoid of known improper voters and (2) that if the County of Yuma has information about improper voters that it either share such information with the City of San Luis so the City of San Luis can take action or the County of Yuma on its own act so that improper voter registration is not perpetuated from election to election.
