

RESOLUTION NO. 232

A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN LUIS, ARIZONA COMMITTING LOCAL FUNDS AS LEVERAGE FOR THE 1990-91 COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT APPLICATION AND RESCINDING RESOLUTION NO. 213.

WHEREAS, the City of San Luis has adopted Resolution No. 208 which authorizes submission of an application to the State of Arizona Department of Commerce for Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) funds for the 1990-91 program year; and

WHEREAS, that application indicates that \$159,545 will be committed by the City of San Luis as leveraged funds, in the form of, e.g. city crew, materials, administrative staff; and

WHEREAS, the Commerce 1990-91 Program Summary requires that all local leveraged funds or resources be committed in the form of a resolution by the governing body, and that such a commitment contain an opinion by the applicant's legal counsel that the leveraged funds represent a binding commitment, legally enforceable under State laws.


WHEREAS, Resolution No. 213, passed and adopted on August 8, 1990, no longer is required by commerce.


