

RESOLUTION NO. 256

A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN LUIS, ARIZONA, IDENTIFYING FISCAL YEAR 1993 COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT AND HOUSING NEEDS AND ACTIVITIES TO BE UNDERTAKEN TO MEET SUCH NEEDS.

WHEREAS, Title I of the Housing and Community Development Act of 1974, as amended, states that the primary objective of the Title and of the community development program of each grantee is the "development of viable urban communities by providing decent housing and a suitable living environment and expanding economic opportunities, principally for persons of low and moderate income..."; and

WHEREAS, Section 106 (d) (2) (D) requires the governor of each state to certify that each unit of general local government to be distributed funds will identify its community development and housing needs, including the needs of low and moderate income person, and the activities to be undertaken to meet such needs.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT the Mayor and City Council of the City of San Luis hereby state that the community development and housing needs of the City of San Luis including the needs of low and moderate income persons are:

1. Ambulance and First Aid Station
2. Public Swimming Pool
3. Sewer Lines for Los Portales del Alamo #3
4. Park Improvements/Youth Center

AND BE FURTHER RESOLVED that the Mayor and City council of the City of San Luis hereby state that the activity proposed to be undertaken with Fiscal Year 1993 CDBG funds to meet such needs are:


1. Sewer lines for Los Portales del Alamo #3

Passed and adopted by the Mayor and City Council of the City of San Luis, Arizona, Yuma County, this 12th, day of August 1992.




