

RESOLUTION NO. 259

A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN LUIS, ARIZONA CERTIFYING THAT THE URGENT NEED HEALTH HAZARD CONDITION TO BE ADDRESSED WITH FISCAL YEAR 1993 CDBG FUNDS DEVELOPED OR BECAME CRITICAL WITHIN 18 MONTHS PRECEDING THE SUBMISSION OF THIS APPLICATION; THAT THE ACTIVITY WILL ALLEVIATE OR ELIMINATE THE CONDITION, AND THAT THERE ARE NO OTHER FINANCIAL RESOURCES AVAILABLE TO MEET THIS NEED.

WHEREAS, the City of San Luis has adopted Resolution No. 255 which authorized the submission of an application to the State of Arizona, Department of Commerce for Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) funds for the 1993 program year, and


WHEREAS, that application indicates that Activities number 2) Sewer Lines for Los Portales del Alamo #3, and 3) Park Improvements will qualify for CDBG funds on the basis of meeting the urgent need-health hazard justification allowed by Title I of the Community Development and Housing Act, as amended, and by the Commerce 1993 Program Summary, and,

WHEREAS, the regulations which govern the State of Arizona's 1993 CDBG program require that any activity meeting this urgent need-health hazard requirement must address a condition that has developed or become critical within 18 months of the date of submission of the application and must alleviate or eliminate this condition, and that the applicant must certify that no other financial resources are available to meet this need,


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Mayor and City Council of the City of San Luis, Arizona, hereby certify that the health hazard-urgent need to be addressed by the 1993 CDBG funded activity development within 18 months of the date of the submission of this application, that the activity will alleviate or eliminate the health hazard-urgent need, and that the City of San Luis has no other financial resources available to address this need.

PASSED AND ADOPTED by the Mayor and City Council of the City of San Luis, Arizona, this 12th day of August 1992.


